We are soliciting industry professionals who are interested in contributing small articles, technical tips and "How-to"-style drafts targeting the TSO/ISPF environment.

What's a small article? No more than 700 words (about one magazine style page), preferably less. 500 words would be ideal.

Topics can be anything that pertains to TSO or ISPF. Examples:

- Writing your own TSO Commands
- Simple (please keep them simple) Edit Macros
- REXX productivity aids
- Programming in the TSO/ISPF environment
- Writing ISPF dialogs
- ISPF usage exploitations
- Historical overviews and evolution of software
- Use your imagination!

If source code accompanies the article/tip, you must be ready, willing (and able) to have it published on the web site in a downloadable format.

There will be a small payment as well as a byline in the newsletter/web site. All published work becomes the property of Chicago-Soft LTD.

We will consider longer drafts but such work might be edited into multiple parts and run as a series.
